I am writing in reference to an athlete, Richard Stewart, who entered high school in 1959. Under normal circumstances this boy is ineligible to participate in athletics this year under the ten semester rule. I am hoping that after reviewing this boy's record you will declare him eligible as a hardship case.

Enclosed you will find copies of this boy's medical record that lists a long line medical history. These records show this boy's frequent visits to the clinic and hospital that alone caused him to miss a number of days out of school. Due to the frequent injuries that this student has encountered, he has been unable to participate the four years that he is entitled to, and was detained one year in a grade that has made it impossible for him to finish with his class.

I feel, as a coach, that due to the circumstances, this boy should be allowed to participate in athletics this year. I hope that you will give this boy and his hospital record your immediate attention and make a ruling as you see fit. He will not be allowed to participate in may sport until we get a final ruling from you.
